



ABOUT DELTA WATER

The water quality in Delta is amongst the best in the world. The Corporation of Delta receives the majority of its water from the Seymour watershed. Seymour source water is filtered and disinfected with UV light, and sodium hypochlorite for primary and secondary disinfection, respectively; lime is added to increase pH and alkalinity while CO₂ is added to adjust pH.

It is not considered “soft water”.

There are NO lead pipes in the Delta School District water system.

Buildings built prior to 1989 have copper piping, and standard practice was to externally solder pipes with a compound that may have included lead.

In 1989, the BC Plumbing Code restricted the use of lead components in solder in all new building water pipes.
